Evaluation is a process that involves collecting and analyzing information about a program's activities, characteristics, and outcomes. Evaluation helps improve program effectiveness and/or inform programming decisions.

Goals are focused, and identify tangible outcomes and targets.



MEASUREABLE

Clearly define what success means and how you will measure it.



ATTAINABLE

Goals should be realistic. Reflect on barriers. Consider steps to achieve goals.



RELEVANT

Do goals align with your values and values of those served?



Every goal should have a target date, and realistic timeline for achieving the goal.
